Project description:

The "Creative Europe" is the European Union's programme to support the cultural and creative sectors. It supports projects with the potential to travel, reach new audiences and encourage skill sharing and development. Armenia, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine participate fully in the Culture sub-programme and partially in the Media programme (Training, Festivals, Film Education and Market Access activities). Partner organisations from non-participating countries such as Azerbaijan and Belarus can be part of any Consortium that has the minimum amount of eligible partners. In the Culture sub-programme a maximum 30% of the allocated funding can be spent in third countries. Armenia is negotiating its participation in the Culture sub-programme of Creative Europe as of 1 January 2018.
