Project description:

This project seeks to continue to promote Council of Europe and international standards and tools in the field of justice, as well as to build the capacity of justice professionals to apply those standards and tools to support improvement of the efficiency of the judicial system, facilitate the modernisation of justice administration, including through implementation of new cyber justice tools, and a continuous improvement of the quality of judicial services with dialogue between justice professionals and the public.

This project is implemented within the third Phase of the joint programme of the European Union and the Council of Europe "Partnership for Good Governance". It builds on the results of the previous phases of the Partnership for Good Governance in the field of strengthening justice (Phase I 2015-2018 and Phase II 2019-2023).

Expected results:

1. Courts adopt quality and efficiency standards and tools;
2. The delivery of efficient and quality judicial services to citizens at the national and court level is enhanced.
3. Court coaching program serves as a good platform to improve court management and disseminate practical measures to other courts.
4. Court performance through strengthened court management is improved.
5. The recourse to mediation is enhanced.
