Project description:

With funding from the European Union and in partnership with the Estonian International Development Centre (ESTDEV), UNDP spearheads the "Inclusive Access to Markets" initiative. (EUR 5,000,000 in EU funding and EUR 162,000 co-funded by UNDP).

This four-year project is designed to empower small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in Georgia, fostering their capabilities to enhance value chains and secure access to the EU and European markets. Aiming to enhance inclusive access to EU markets for Georgian SMEs, the project drives the following key activities:
