### Project description:

Occupational Health and Safety (OSH) concerns all citizens whether they work in a factory, in an office, sell goods in a shop or take care of patients in a hospital. EU OSH legislation and its national transposition creates the framework for improvement of healthy and safe working conditions for enterprises and employees which are the preconditions for healthy and productive workforce. The Twinning project aims to support Georgia in the implementation of EU-related commitments related to approximation, awareness and enforcement of EU acquis in OSH, in particular, a) aligning the primary and secondary legislation related to OSH in accordance with the Union acquis; b) strengthening the capacity of Labour Inspection Office and other stakeholders for full enforcement of the newly adopted OSH regulations; c) raising the public awareness on OSH among the general population and especially among employers and employees in both public and private sectors.

### Expected results:

1. Legal framework on OSH is in compliance with the Union acquis
2. The capacity of Labour Inspection Office and other stakeholders strengthened for full enforcement of the newly adopted OSH regulations
3. Awareness on safe and healthy working environments in the public and private sector increased
