Project description:

The project is part of European Neighborhood Programme for Agriculture and Rural Development (ENPARD) and contributes to the reduction of poverty in Imereti region. The project utilizes the LEADER methodology that supports inclusive and participatory approaches to local development. Through this methodology, voices of community members within local development planning is promoted and their involvement in decision-making processes is enhanced to improve quality of life and economic well-being of rural communities.

As a principal mechanism of this approach, Local Action Group (LAG) was established in Tskaltubo, which is a public-private partnership of local community members that represent a broad cross-section of different groups and sectors within the municipality. The LAG has recently produced Local Development Strategy for Tskaltubo Municipality and is planning to fund local projects and initiatives that support rural development
